Membership Renewal: It's time to renew your-Cabrillo memberships! Club memberships run from June 1 through May 31 each year. Membership dues remain \$8/year. Of that \$8, approximately \$6 goes for insurance (all members are insured by the United Square Dancers of America Insurance Program. Should you be hurt while dancing at the Park, this policy will cover your secondary expenses), another 50¢ for IDA (International Dance Association of San Diego County, our mother organization which overseas all the clubs in the Park) publicity. In addition each club contributes to the IDA \$20/year for membership, and \$20 for the IDA International Dance Festival each February. Cabrillo also belongs to the Folk Dance Federation of California, South, and we pay \$1/member to this organization which promotes Folk Dancing, and puts on the Statewide Festival (this is the big festival we hosted in May 2015). Any funds left goes to buy music or equipment for the club. With a membership, your class fee goes from \$2.50 to \$2/week, and this fee pays the teachers. Chin and Georgina have agreed to split the usual \$30/ class each week except for the weeks when Chin has the program to herself--then she gets \$20. Same goes for Georgina--she gets \$20 on the weeks Chin is not able to come.

The last paragraph applies to FULL Members. You may join Cabrillos for just \$4/year to become an AS-SOCIATE Member which gives you the reduced class fee. An Associate Member must be a full member of another IDA club. Most of our associate members are full members of SDFD, SDIFDC, Kayso, or Waltz'n'Such, but you can look up which clubs belong to the IDASDC on the website:
