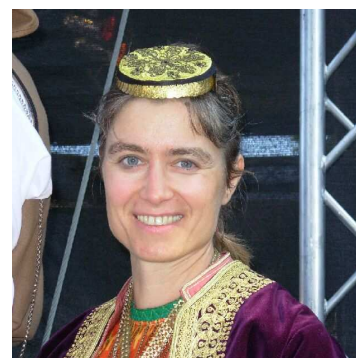

**Kristalli Bio:**



Ms. Papadopoulos, originally from Darmstadt, Germany, has a BA in Dance Pedagogy from Hamburg. She has performed & taught Greek folk dance for 25 years in Europe, & continues her career in North America.

Her heritage and her specialty is teaching the dances from Pontos, Greek Macedonia & Thrace. For 30 years she has studied with prominent Greek teachers, including Kyriakos Moisisdis, Petros Selkos, & Nikos Zournandsidis.

While living in Thessaloniki for 2 years of intense study of Greek culture, Kristalli developed a holistic teaching program for dance. With this method she is able to help students understand a deeper understanding of Greek folk music, movement & rhythms. Currently Kristalli lives in Northern California, with her husband, and has begun her practice in bodywork & healing. Along with her work as a physical therapist, she teaches Greek dance to the folkdance community.
