He would like to open a Greek restaurant that caters to the dance community so what we are doing now is looking to either lease/buy an existing restaurant that would also support a good size dance floor, or find a space that we could put a restaurant into. We are already looking into a number of places that suit our needs.

Due to a lack of a qualified teacher on Monday's and in turn a lack of attendance, we will be suspending the Monday evening class till further notice.
